

Volunteers—Vulnerable **Sector Check**

BHNCDSB has a new letter/form for parents who require a new VSC (Vulnerable Sector Check) in order to volunteer at school, chaperone on field trips, etc. The new letter is now electronic and must be emailed to the parent after being signed by the principal. It is then uploaded to police services when completing the VSC request online. You can contact the office if you require this form to apply/ renew your VSC.

Did you know??? Your Vulnerable Sector Check is nontransferrable, meaning, if you have one to coach your child's sports team (hockey, soccer, etc.) you cannot use the same one to volunteer at school.
